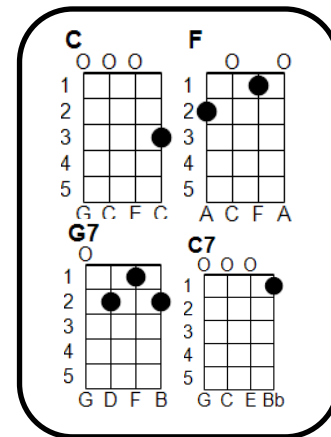
[C] I hear the train a comin' it's rolling round the bend
