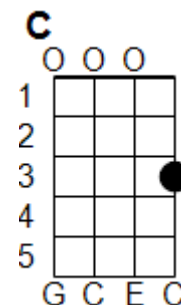
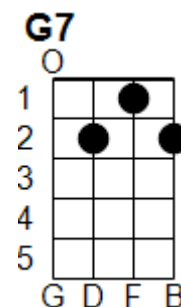


Jambalaya (On the Bayou) Hank Williams Sr. 1952
