[Am] Under the [D] quarter [G] moon. [D - G]

[G] Would that [D] I pos-[C] sessed your [G] vision

Ending: repeat the last line of chorus, gradually slowing, then hold the word "quarter", then hold "moon" with the chords G, D, C, G, then stop singing and just play the chords Am, D, G-D-G --Peggy
