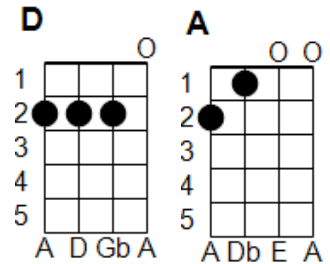


WHEN MY BLUE MOON TURNS TO GOLD AGAIN
