

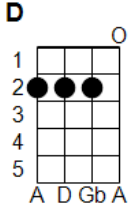
The Wild Rover

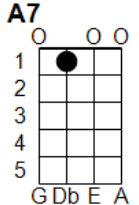
And it's [A7] no, nay, never {4 claps} [D] No, nay, never, no [G] more,
